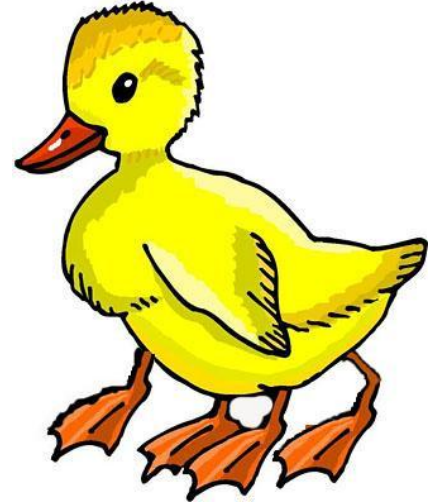


Bible Fowls
